9. Selection of candidates will be made through interviews. The NFSU-PMU reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview on the basis of screening tests and for on the basis of experience if the number of applications received in response to this advertisement is large. No correspondence will be entertained from the applicants who are not shortlisted for the interview.
10. The candidate has to produce one set of self-certified documents (degree/marksheet/experience certificate, etc.) at the time of the Interview.

11. All the original certificate(s) must be shown to the Selection Committee if selected for the post.
12. The posts listed above are temporary positions on a contractual basis for 5 months that can be extended further, based on a project requirement and mutual agreement between NFSU and other stakeholders.
13. The candidates selected can be posted at NFSU, Gandhinagar, Gujarat Campus or any other campus(es) of NFSU as per the requirement of the project.
14. Upon selection, the candidates will be required to produce a notarized Undertaking and Non-Disclosure Agreement with the department.
15. In-service candidates, have to submit a relieving order from their earlier employer at the time of joining, if he / she is selected for the Project.
16. The NFSU-PMU reserves the right to increase or decrease the positions and fill or not to fill positions in any of the above and/or any other specialization(s).
17. All qualifications must be from UGC recognized University /Deemed university/AICTE approved Autonomous Institution (wherever applicable). The courses offered by Autonomous Institutions should be equivalent to the relevant course approved/ recognized by the Association of Indian University (AIU).
